### **New functionality in the eFiling System to track compliance with decision directions and conditions**

The Alberta Utilities Commission will be updating the eFiling System on March 10, 2018, by adding new tracking functionality to assist applicants, interveners and AUC staff members with an effective, efficient and transparent way to track directions and conditions from its decisions. The new tracking functionality will display clear deadlines for compliance with decision directions and will track the status of compliance with direction and condition requirements such as:

- construction reports
- environmental studies
- noise impact assessments
- reclamation notices
- safety requirements and reporting
- administrative reports

Historically, the AUC tracked compliance matters through internal systems, but this was labour intensive and did not provide staff with a standardized way to communicate expectations to applicants or report the status and results.

Using familiar navigation, terminology and functionality, the eFiling System will now enable parties to easily find directions and conditions that have been assigned to them and to know the status. The system has been equipped to notify the party responsible for fulfilling the direction and condition with an automatic reminder notification that will be sent by email, usually 14 days prior to the due date.

The eFiling System manual will be updated to reflect this new functionality and will be available for the release on March 10, 2018. There will also be a quick tip version of instructions, available on your eFiling System home screen upon initial sign in, to help navigate the directions.
