AUC Rule 012: Noise Control – Workshop on Rule 012 changes

The Alberta Utilities Commission regulates noise associated with electric and gas pipeline facilities. In December 2017, the Commission initiated a consultation process on changes to certain provisions of Rule 012: *Noise Control*. The Commission approved amendments to Rule 012 on April 16, 2019. The final results of the consultation process are a [revised Rule 012](#) and a [revised Rule 007](#), which have been issued and published on the AUC website. The amendments to these rules are effective August 1, 2019.

Prior to the amendments coming into effect, the Commission would like to gauge stakeholder interest in a workshop led by AUC staff that would summarize the major changes to Rule 012 and provide a forum to ask questions arising from the amendments. The Commission has tentatively scheduled two workshops, one in Calgary and one in Edmonton.

Depending on the level of stakeholder interest, the Commission may decide to cancel one or both of these workshops and if only a single workshop is held, it will be held in Calgary.

Because of space limitations, the Commission encourages attendance from no more than two participants from each organization. The Commission has teleconferencing capabilities in its Edmonton and Calgary offices that will allow stakeholders from Edmonton to participate in the Calgary workshop and stakeholders from Calgary to participate in the Edmonton workshop. Please advise if you intend to participate by teleconference.
