

Release summary

An updated version of the eFiling System is being released on November 12, 2016. The focus of this particular release (version 1.02.00) is on a major enhancement for automation of exhibit replacement.

These release notes provide the details of the release and are broken down into three areas: new features, known issues and fixes. The details are grouped by functional areas.

New features

A new feature is a functional change that has been requested and approved to be incorporated into the system.

Dispositions

When a disposition is rescinded (replaced) by a newer disposition, a hyperlink to the **Disposition details** page of the proceeding with the new disposition has been added. The hyperlink is located in the **Status reason** on the **Disposition details** screen of the rescinded disposition.

Documents

A major enhancement has been implemented to provide the functionality to support filing of revisions as outlined in Section 15 of Rule 001 including:

- Providing a mechanism for external registered parties or internal staff to file revised application or filing documents on active proceedings.
- Ensuring that only a single document already assigned an exhibit number can be revised and only certain types of documents are eligible for revision.
- Indicating what documents have been revised through an exhibit number extension.
- Notifying team members and registered parties that a revised document has been added or removed.
- Enforcing the blacklined and clean version requirements of Rule 001, Section 15.
- Automatically assigning a single exhibit number to the blacklined and clean versions.
- Enforcing the rules for the exhibit number convention.
- Displaying the latest blacklined version on the **Documents** screen.
- Providing a view to a revision history where both the blacklined and clean versions can be accessed for the latest and all previous versions as well as the original.
- Enabling the search of revision documents and filtering search results by revision status or revision type.

Known issues

A known issue is a problem with the system that has been reported and requires additional investigation.

There are no outstanding issues reported for the eFiling System on the AUC website.

Fixes

A fix is a correction to the system where it was producing an error or was not operating as originally designed.

Applicants/registered parties

The ability to filter participants when multiple parties have the same name has been corrected.

Documents

Voided and withdrawn documents are now removed from the **Recent documents** list on the Home page.

The exhibit numbers will now be applied in sequence of the order the application documents were actually uploaded.
