

Release summary

An updated version of the eFiling System is being released on June 9, 2018. The focus of this particular release (version 1.03.01) is on minor enhancements and defects.

These release notes provide the details of the release and are broken down into three areas: new features, known issues and fixes. The details are grouped by functional areas.

New features

A new feature is a functional change that has been requested and approved to be incorporated into the system.

Applications

Six new application types have been added into eFiling to be compliant with Bill 13:

Standard Independent System Operator rule – new - Filings pursuant to Section 20.2 of the *Electric Utilities Act* and *Rule 017: Procedures and Process for Developing Independent System Operator Rules* for new independent system operator rules.

Standard Independent System Operator rule – amendment - Filings pursuant to Section 20.2 of the *Electric Utilities Act* and *Rule 017: Procedures and Process for Developing Independent System Operator Rules* with the Alberta Utilities Commission for amendments to independent system operator rules.

Standard Independent System Operator rule – removal - Filings pursuant to Section 20.2 of the *Electric Utilities Act* and *Rule 017: Procedures and Process for Developing Independent System Operator Rules* for removal of independent system operator rules.

Provisional Independent System Operator rule - Filings pursuant to Section 20.2, Section 20.22, and Section 41.42 of the *Electric Utilities Act* and *Rule 017: Procedures and Process for Developing Independent System Operator Rules* for independent system operator rules considered essential to establish and for operation of the capacity market.

Expedited Independent System Operator rule – urgent - Filings pursuant to Section 20.6(2)(a) of the *Electric Utilities Act* and *Rule 017: Procedures and Process for Developing Independent System Operator Rules* for expedited new, expedited amendments or expedited removal of independent system operator rules that are urgent and affects the reliable supply of electricity or the safe and reliable operation of the interconnected electric system.

Expedited Independent System Operator rule – non-urgent - Filings pursuant to Section 20.6(2)(b) of the *Electric Utilities Act* and *Rule 017: Procedures and Process for Developing Independent System Operator Rules* for expedited new, expedited amendments or expedited removal of independent system operator rules for purposes that do not affect the reliable supply of electricity or the safe and reliable operation of the interconnected electric system.

Four application types have been retired to accommodate Bill 13:

Independent system operator rule expedited
Independent system operator rule new
Independent system operator rule amendment
Independent system operator rule removal

Known issues

A known issue is a problem with the system that has been reported and requires additional investigation.

There are no outstanding issues reported for the eFiling System on the AUC website.

Fixes

A fix is a correction to the system where it was producing an error or was not operating as originally designed.

Applications

The validation has been corrected on the substation application form for questions 5 and 6.

Question 4 on the power plant form now allows a decimal point and then a zero after the whole number.

Validation has been added preventing the same unit number to be applied to multiple location records on the power plant form.

The electric facility ID may now be added to the following application types:

Needs identification document
Needs stipulation
Transmission enquiry proposal
Transmission interconnection
Transmission ownership change
Transmission lines
Substation

A power plant form may now be edited when the expected plant in-service date has passed.

Application and registration forms

The application forms have been modified to ensure that the user can see all text in the comment boxes. The boxes will expand automatically when long text strings are added and the text will now wrap appropriately on the printed forms.

The representative contact information is now included on the PDF version of the application form when registering to represent a primary applicant. Even if a representative registers after the initial registration of the primary applicant, the PDF version of the application form is updated to include the representative contact information.

Directions

The ability to allow a representative to file application or filing documents and associate them to a direction assigned to the party they represent, has been added.

The overdue listing on priority directions will include those directions with a status of *Under review* if the due date has passed.

Tool tips have been added on the direction details screen for the originating and satisfying disposition and the originating proceeding.

Documents

The zip and download function has been corrected to ensure that if a user has multiple tabs open in an internet browser, only the selected documents from the proceeding on the active browser tab will be downloaded.

Find

The calendar controls have been updated on all of the Find screens to allow a user to enter a date that is months or years away from the current date. A user may now select a specific month or year instead of scrolling through the months.

The date format on the Find filings search results has been updated to be consistent with the rest of the system.

Help

Links to all of the Quick tip guides and the eFiling system user guide can now be accessed from the How do I... top navigation menu item.

Search

Clicking the link on a disposition record returned from a search will now take the user to the individual disposition details screen (instead of the list of all dispositions on the proceeding).
