Digital Data Submission	Allow Removal of Attachments for Unregistered Submissions	Applicants now have the ability to remove attachments that they have uploaded mistakenly through EAS on unregistered submissions.
	Address Multiple Primary Contacts for E-mail Notifications	When using Submit Application or Participate in a Proceeding, external stakeholders and will be restricted to a single e-mail per one contact. This prevents multiple e-mails on one contact which was leading to system problems.
	Update to the Help Files	The online help has been updated to reflect all changes made in the system since April 2009. The DDS and E-Filing user guides have all been updated and issued to include all current functionality.
	Application Submission File Upload Technical Redesign	The process for transferring files from the web into Sharepoint via EAS has been optimized. Applicants can expect improved performance when uploading documents. As well, the time from upload to when a document becomes available on the Web has been reduced.
Proceeding Search	Suppress Personal information on the Registered Parties List	In accordance with the Alberta Utilities Commission FOIP procedures, the registered parties information has been removed from the Web. In a subsequent release, this information will be available to registered parties. To gain this information currently, registered or interested parties must contact info@auc.ab.ca .
	Proceeding Submission List Sort Order not Working	The sort was broken on the submission list and had been reported by an external user. This has been fixed so it sorts correctly.
Application Search, Digital Data Submission, Proceeding Search, Proceeding Submission	Curriculum Vitae Submission Type	The submission type of "Curriculum Vitae" has been added with the following description: A synopsis of one's education, experience and professional qualifications. The default protective marking for this submission type has been set to "registered parties".
	Allow for Electronic Submission of Law Division Applications	Cost and Review and Variance Phase I applications for the Law Division can now be submitted through EAS and managed through IAR, including dispositioning. Law applications can now be searched for easily using Applications Search and can utilize all proceeding functionality.
	New Design Format for Notifications	Notifications now have new AUC designs for DDS, EAS Application Replacement/ Subsequent Attachment, EAS Application Registration, EPS New Group Member, EPS Proceeding Completed, EPS New Representative, EPS Submission Withdrawn notification.
	Remove AUC Logo and Swoosh	As it was causing confusion for external stakeholders, we have removed the AUC logo and swoosh from e-mails as the pictures were not rendering in the e-mail effectively for some users. We have expanded the AUC the body title to the complete name Alberta Utilities Commission is presented.
