AltaLink Management Ltd. (Operator), pursuant to Permit and Licence No.U2002-511, is the operator of Buffalo Creek 526S substation. By Application No. 1605252, registered on July 10, 2010 (the Application), the Operator applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) for approval to decommission this existing substation, to salvage existing equipment at the substation, to re-build a new substation at a location immediately north (Alteration), and to operate the new Buffalo Creek 526S substation.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 14 and 15 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the Application in Decision 2010-095 and granted to the Operator a Permit to alter and a Licence to operate the Buffalo Creek 526S substation subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* (the Acts), any Regulations made under the Acts, any Orders made under the Acts, the Commission Rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The Buffalo Creek 526S substation shall be wholly located in the southwest quarter of Section 12, Township 48, Range 9, and West of the 4th Meridian;
2. Specifications of the Buffalo Creek 526S substation shall be and include as follows:
  - a) two (2) 15/20/25-MVA 138/25-kV LTC transformers;
  - b) three (3) 138-kV circuit breakers;
  - c) three (3) 25-kV circuit breakers;
  - d) one (1) 18.92-MVAR capacitor bank;
  - e) associated substation equipment; and
  - f) an enclosure surrounded by a chain link fence and other substation equipment as described in the Application.
3. The Operator shall file with the Commission, within 30 days of completing the Alteration, the Energization Certificates for the Buffalo Creek 526S substation issued by the Alberta Electric System Operator and by the Operator respectively to confirm that the Alteration has been completed and is being operated in accordance with the provisions of this Permit and Licence;

4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, Alteration of the Buffalo Creek 526S substation shall be completed by December 31, 2010;
5. The Commission may cancel or suspend this Permit and Licence, in whole or in part, in accordance with section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this Permit and Licence, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*; and
6. Permit and Licence No. U2002-511 is rescinded.
