

NRGreen Power Ltd. is the holder of Power Plant Approval No. U2008-159 to construct and operate an 8.0-MW waste-heat, electric generating unit (Power Plant) at the existing Alliance Pipeline Irma mainline compressor station in the Irma area.

Pursuant to section 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, the Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) approved Application No. 1605912 in Decision 2010-106 for an extension of time to construct and operate the Power Plant subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* (Acts), any Regulations made under the Acts, any Orders made under the Acts, the Commission Rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The Power Plant shall be located in LSD 4, Section 11, Township 47, Range 9, West of the 4th Meridian, as described in Application No. 1559262;
2. The Power Plant shall consist of one 8.0-MW waste-heat ORMAT generating unit, as further described in Application No. 1559262;
3. NRGreen Power Ltd. shall submit a progress report to the Commission in writing, once every three months, on construction progress pursuant to section 3 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Regulation*;
4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, construction of the Power Plant shall be completed by December 31, 2011;
5. NRGreen Power Ltd. shall notify the Commission within 30 days of completing the Power Plant in accordance with the provisions of this Approval;
6. NRGreen Power Ltd. shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any material changes to the Power Plant or substantially varying the design or specifications of the Power Plant from those stated in Application No. 1559262 or specified in this Approval;
7. This Approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission;

8. The Commission may cancel or suspend this Approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*; and
9. Power Plant Approval No. U2008-159 is rescinded.
