AltaLink Management Ltd. (Operator) by Application No. 1603771, registered on January 26, 2009 applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) for approval to construct and operate Lakesend 508S substation (Substation).

Clause 4 of Permit and Licence No. U2009-299 provided that the Substation was to be completed by March 31, 2010. Clause 4 also provided that upon application by the Operator, the Commission may stipulate a later date for completing the Substation. By Application No. 1605963 registered on March 5, 2010 (the Application), the Operator requested a stipulation for an extension of time to construct the Substation.

The Commission, pursuant to section 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the Application in Decision 2010-122, and pursuant to sections 14 and 15 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* granted the Operator a Permit to construct and a Licence to operate the Substation, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* (the Acts), any Regulations made under the Acts, any Orders made under the Acts, the Commission Rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The Substation shall be wholly located in LSD 9 of Section 28, Township 38, Range 8, West of the 4th Meridian;
2. Specifications of the Substation shall include the following:
  - (a) one 15/20/25-MVA, 144/4.16-kV transformer;
  - (b) one 170-kV circuit breaker; and
  - (c) an enclosure surrounded by a chain link fence and other substation equipment as described in the Application No. 1603771;
3. The Operator shall file with the Commission, within 30 days of completing the Substation, the Energization Certificate for the Substation issued by the Alberta Electric System Operator and by the Operator respectively to confirm that the Substation has been completed and is being operated in accordance with the provisions of this Permit and Licence;

4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, the Substation shall be completed by July 31, 2010;
5. The Commission may cancel or suspend this Licence, in whole or in part, in accordance with section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this Licence, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*; and
6. Permit and Licence No. U2009-299 is rescinded.
