Western Alberta Transmission Line (WATL) application
Process meeting on April 20, 2011**

The process meeting for the WATL application is on April 20, 2011 in the Harvest Centre in Westerner Park, at 4847A Nineteenth Street, Red Deer, Alberta. It will commence at 9 a.m. and end at 5 p.m. or earlier if the full day is not required. The goal of the process meeting is to establish a schedule and a process for that schedule for the fair and effective consideration of the WATL application.

- Comments regarding the location of the hearing and the proposed proceeding schedule.

Presentations should not address the merits of the application; such concerns will be considered in the public hearing itself. Furthermore, presentations should not address the need for the proposed WATL project as need is an issue that the Commission cannot consider for this application.
