NOTICE OF FILING OF EXPEDITED ISO RULE

APPLICATION NO. 1606208

Take Notice that the Independent System Operator (ISO), as defined in the *Electric Utilities Act*, filed amendments to the following expedited ISO rule on May 17, 2010 (Expedited ISO Rule) with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or Commission) pursuant to subsection 20.6(2) of the *Electric Utilities Act* and AUC Rule 017 – *Procedures and Process for Development of ISO Rules and Filing of ISO Rules with the Alberta Utilities Commission*:

Nature of Application

Rule Number	Description
OPP 517	Keephills/Ellerslie/Genesee (KEG) Area Operation

[Note: OPP refers to Operating Policies and Procedures of the ISO, and OPPs are ISO rules.]

OPP 517 has confidential Tables 3 and 4 (Confidential Tables) that contain the KEG area generators contracted supply transmission service levels and KEG area generators minimum stable generation levels. The ISO indicated this information is considered to be commercially sensitive information by the KEG area generators, and that disclosure of the Confidential Tables would not be in the public interest.
