Dear Market Participants and Interested Parties:

**Re: AESO Reply to Stakeholder Comments – Proposed Level II “Package 5” Amendments to ISO Rule Section G1 Definitions (“ Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes”) Previously consulted on as Proposed Level II “Package 3” Amendments to and Removal of Existing ISO Rule Section G1 Definitions**

In accordance Section 8 of Alberta Utilities Commission (“AUC’ or Commission”) Rule 017, the Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) is required to provide a reply to stakeholder comments regarding the Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes. A Letter of Notice setting out the proposed changes to the G1 Definitions Changes was distributed for consultation on May 7, 2010. The Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes being recommended for internal AESO approval in June 2010 are attached.

**Transition of Authoritative Documents (“TOAD”) Reform**

The Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes are the result of a specific Transition of Authoritative Documents project (“TOAD”). Under TOAD, the AESO is endeavoring to eliminate duplication, to address conflicts and gaps and to improve clarity within its three authoritative document domains: the ISO rules, the ISO tariff and the Alberta Reliability Standards. **Summary of Amendments**

The Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes are summarized as follows:

1. The Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes contain further amendments to certain of the definitions for the following terms, all of which were previously issued for consultation as part of “Package 3” G1 Definitions Changes:
  - a) apparent power,
  - b) metered demand,
  - c) metered energy,
  - d) power factor,
  - e) real power, and
  - f) reactive power.

**AESO Reply to Stakeholder Comments**

Please note that no written comments were received by the AESO on the proposed G1 Definitions Changes as set out in the AESO’s May 7, 2010 Letter of Notice.

The AESO is expecting to file the Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes with the Commission on June 28, 2010.



In accordance with Section 20.4 of the *Electric Utilities Act* (“EUA”), market participants, may object to an ISO rule filed with the Commission within 10 days of the publication by the Commission of the notice of filing of the ISO rule.

In accordance with Section 20.3 of the EUA, the Final Proposed G1 Definitions Changes are proposed to be effective on July 15, 2010.
