Changes to Appendix A of Rule 007 – Application for Power Plants, Substations, Transmission Lines, and Industrial System Designations

On April 21, 2009, the Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) decided to revoke the current Appendix A, Participant Involvement Program Requirements, of *Rule 007, Application for Power Plants, Substations, Transmission Lines, and Industrial System Designations* and reinstate Appendix A, as it existed prior to the changes of March 24, 2009. Also, the change to TS 11 has been revoked and replaced with the previous version of this item as it relates to Appendix A.

The reason for the change is that the Commission was made aware of unintended consequences of the changes to Appendix A. As a result, the Commission wants to conduct further consultations with interested persons regarding Appendix A and any other changes to Rule 007. To help ensure an efficient and effective consultation process, the Commission will hold meetings at which Commissioners will be in attendance. The starting point for the consultation is Appendix A dated March 24, 2009.

The Commission will announce the date and time and place of the consultation meetings in the next short while.
