Issue / Topic	AUC Response
Issue 1: Asset is no longer defined in the AESO’s <i>Consolidated Authoritative Document Glossary</i>	
<p>Alberta Electric System Operator</p> <p>Under section 2, Definitions, the Bulletin refers to the term “asset” as defined in the AESO’s Consolidated Authoritative Document Glossary (“CADG”). However, this term is not defined in the AESO’s CADG.</p> <p>As such, the AESO suggests that the term “asset” could be replaced with the terms “transmission facility”, “aggregated generating facility” and “generating unit”, as defined in the AESO’s CADG. These are the units/facilities to which ISO identifiers, referred to in subsection 3.2(b) of the Bulletin, may be assigned.</p>	<p>The Commission will change the definition of “asset” to mean “pool asset or transmission facility as defined in the Alberta Electric System Operator’s <i>Consolidated Authoritative Document Glossary</i>.” Pool asset is inclusive of generating units, aggregated generating facilities, load assets, import assets and export assets.</p>
Issue 2: Extra asterisk on PRC-023-AB-2 (R3-R5)	
<p>The Market Surveillance Administrator</p> <p>Under Category 2 in the Penalty Table, the reference to reliability standard PRC-023-AB-2 (R3-R5) should be followed by a single asterisk (rather than a double asterisk).</p>	<p>The Commission has removed the extra asterisk.</p>
