Stakeholder consultation on AUC Rule 028: Natural Gas Settlement System Code Rules

The Alberta Utilities Commission is inviting written comments from interested parties as it revises and updates AUC Rule 028: *Natural Gas Settlement System Code Rules* (Rule 028). The proposed revisions to Rule 028 reflect the consultations undertaken by AUC staff to date with representatives of gas distributors, default supply providers, load settlement agents, retailers and billing agents, as well as with staff of the Office of the Utilities Consumer Advocate.

The Commission is now seeking comments from interested parties regarding a proposed version 1.5 of Rule 028. This bulletin, along with a draft of version 1.5 of Rule 028 and a table for providing comment, will be posted on the Rule Development, Rule 028 – Natural Gas Settlement System Code portion of the AUC’s website. Parties who wish to provide written comments on version 1.5 of Rule 028 should do so using the table for providing comment. All written submissions must be directed to Andrea Laroiya, a senior advisor in the AUC’s market oversight and enforcement division at regulatorypolicy@auc.ab.ca by 12 p.m. (noon) on Monday, November 30, 2015.

Once comments have been received and reviewed, the Commission will proceed to finalize version 1.5 of Rule 028 prior to January 1, 2016, so that market participants have the opportunity to implement the proposed changes during 2016.
