Stakeholder comments sought for changes to AUC Rule 024: Rules Respecting Micro-Generation

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) is inviting written comments from interested parties regarding proposed changes to AUC Rule 024: *Rules Respecting Micro-Generation*. The proposed changes to Rule 024 arise from the amendments to the *Micro-Generation Regulation* and comments received from representatives of wire owners, meter services providers, the Alberta Electric System Operator and the Office of the Utilities Consumer Advocate at a meeting held on January 25, 2017.

To facilitate comments from interested parties regarding the proposed changes, this bulletin, along with a draft of version 1.0 of Rule 024 and a table for providing comment will be posted on the AUC website under the Rule Development tab, Rule 024 – Rules respecting Micro-Generation area. Parties who wish to provide written comments on the draft Rule 024 should do so using the table for providing comment. All written submissions are to be directed to Rose Ferrer, a regulatory analyst in the AUC’s Market Oversight and Enforcement division at regulatorypolicy@auc.ab.ca by 4 p.m. on April 13, 2017.

Once comments have been received and reviewed, the Commission intends to proceed to finalize the revised Rule 024 by the end of May, 2017.
