AUC Rule 024: Rules Respecting Micro-Generation

AUC Rule 007: Applications for Power Plants, Substations, Transmission Lines, Industrial System Designations and Hydro Developments

AUC Rule 012: Noise Control

The Alberta Utilities Commission has been working with stakeholders to identify required improvements and revisions to AUC Rule 024: *Rules Respecting Micro-Generation* (Rule 024) to keep the rule relevant and reflective of the amendments made to the *Micro-Generation Regulation* in December, 2016.

In an effort to ensure that changes made to Rule 024 remain consistent with other AUC rules, consequential amendments have also been made to AUC Rule 007: *Applications for Power Plants, Substations, Transmission Lines, Industrial System Designations and Hydro Developments* (Rule 007) and AUC Rule 012: *Noise Control* (Rule 012). Additional changes were made to Rule 007 to update the ranges of cost estimates that may be included in an application in light of the adoption of ISO Rule 504.5.

As a result of the review, the Commission approved changes to Rule 024 (version 1.0), Rule 007 and Rule 012 on June 15, 2017. Changes made to these rules will be effective on July 4, 2017.

Materials related to the Rule 024 consultation process, including a summary of changes to Rule 024, comments received from stakeholders and the AUC's responses, are posted on the AUC's website under the Consultations tab, Rule 024 – Rules Respecting Micro-Generation.

The AUC thanks stakeholders for their time and participation in the consultation process and for their efforts in reviewing and providing comments on the proposed changes to the rule.
