Updated Micro-generation notice submission guideline released, forms changed and removed from appendix in Rule 024: Rules Respecting Micro-Generation

The Alberta Utilities Commission worked with stakeholders, including wires owners and the Alberta Electric System Operator, to update the AUC's [Micro-generation notice submission guideline](#). The revised guideline summarizes the current processes required to obtain approval for micro-generation connection to the grid. The guideline reflects the updated safety, electric and procedural information and has been modernized with new graphics for illustration purposes.

As a result of the work completed on the guideline, the associated forms in [Rule 024: Rules Respecting Micro-Generation](#) have been removed from the rule to specify form content without restricting form format.
