ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO) applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 2045 for the following:

- splitting of line 10 into lines 10 and 16
- removal of line 16
- splitting of line 5 into lines 5 and 17
- removal of line 5
- pipe grade amendment of line 5 from grade 207 to grade A
- addition of newly constructed pipeline (line 18 – 0.75 kilometres of 114.3-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)

The Commission amended Licence 2045 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 22625-D01-2017¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
