Interim time extension

1. Imperial Oil Limited (Imperial), by Application 22214-A001 registered with the Alberta Utilities Commission on November 28, 2016, requested approval of a time extension in order to complete construction of a 43-megawatt cogeneration power plant at the Imperial Strathcona refinery located in Strathcona County, east of the city of Edmonton.
2. The proposed work is related to facilities previously approved by the Commission in Approval 3194-D02-2015,¹ where December 31, 2016, was stipulated as the deadline date to complete the project. On December 21, 2016, the Commission issued Decision 22215-D01-2016,² granting an interim time extension of Approval 3194-D02-2015 until March 31, 2017.
3. The Commission issued information requests to Imperial regarding the application that are still outstanding but which Imperial has indicated that it will respond to by May 19, 2017. In order to allow Imperial the necessary time to respond to the information requests and the Commission sufficient time to consider the application, the Commission by way of this letter, grants a further interim extension of Approval 3194-D02-2015 until July 31, 2017, under Subsection 8(5) of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
