2015-2016 transmission general tariff application

Proceeding 22651 TransAlta Corporation

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering TransAlta Corporation's 2015-2016 transmission general tariff application to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

TransAlta Corporation, as Manager of the TransAlta Generation Partnership, filed an application in accordance with Section 37 of the *Electric Utilities Act*, requesting approval for TransAlta Corporation's 2015-2016 transmission general tariff application, as well as the reconciliation of certain deferral and reserve accounts for 2013 and 2014.

More specifically, TransAlta Corporation is requesting approval from the AUC of the following:

- 2015 revenue requirement of \$4,794,861 and rates to recover same
- 2016 revenue requirement of \$6,142,140 and rates to recover same
- 2015-2016 transmission facility owner's rate and terms and conditions
- reserves, deferral accounts and other aspects of the proposed tariff
- capital deferral account reconciliation for directly assigned capital projects for the years 2013 and 2014
- operating deferral account reconciliation for property taxes and payments in lieu of property taxes for the years 2013 and 2014
- operating deferral account reconciliation for actual tower payments versus the approved placeholder amounts for 2013 and 2014

Written submissions are due May 29, 2017.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 22651. If you do not have access to the Internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended,

and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
