Application for 2018 system access service rates

Proceeding 22932 EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.'s application for 2018 system access service (SAS) rates to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

EPCOR is requesting approval for the following SAS rates:

- The 2018 SAS rates reflecting the Alberta Electric System Operator's (AESO) 2017 Independent System Operator tariff approved in Decision 22093-D02-2017.¹
- The 2018 Balancing Pool allocation rider, reflecting the AESO's Balancing Pool consumer allocation rider, AESO Rider F, approved in Decision 22248-D01-2016.²

Written submissions are due September 25, 2017.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 22932. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
