Time extension

1. ENMAX Generation Portfolio Inc. (EGPI), by Application 22984-A001 registered with the Alberta Utilities Commission on September 28, 2017, requested approval of a time extension in order to complete construction of a 3.3-megawatt natural gas-fired combined heat and power cogeneration system at the ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre (the project).
2. The proposed work is related to facilities previously approved by the Commission in Approval 21247-D02-2016,¹ where December 31, 2017, was stipulated as the completion date for the project.
3. EGPI stated the project has experienced a delay with respect to the delivery of an exhaust assembly, delaying the commercial operation by approximately three months. EGPI indicated the exhaust assembly would arrive from Europe in November 2017 and, as such, requested a time extension for the completion of the project to March 31, 2018.
4. EGPI advised the Commission of a revision to the stack design for the project. EGPI stated that better performance would be obtained by using a different model of stack silencer, resulting in lower emissions, better attenuation of exhaust noise, and adherence with approved uses of the local planning bylaw. EGPI also stated that the revision does not change any of the terms and conditions of Approval 21247-D02-2016.
5. EGPI has provided information respecting the need, nature and the duration of the requested time extension. Based upon the information provided, EGPI has demonstrated that the requested time extension is of a minor nature.
6. The Commission approves a time extension to June 30, 2018, for the completion of construction of the project. The Commission acknowledges the revision to the stack design and

notes that the change does not alter the design or specifications of the power plant from what the Commission previously approved.
