ENMAX Generation Portfolio Inc. Time Extension to construct ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre 3.3-MW Natural Gas-Fired Power Plant	Proceeding 22984 Application 22984-A001

ENMAX Generation Portfolio Inc. (EGPI), pursuant to Approval 21247-D02-2016,¹ has approval to construct and operate a 3.3-megawatt natural gas-fired combined heat and power cogeneration system at the ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre located at 435 Ninth Avenue S.E. Calgary, Alberta. The construction completion date for the power plant was stipulated to be on or before December 31, 2017.

EGPI, by Application 22984-A001, registered on September 28, 2017, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval to extend the completion date of the power plant.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 11 and 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 22984-D01-2017,² and granted to EGPI an approval to construct and operate the power plant, subject to the provisions of *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in the southeast quarter of Section 15, Township 24, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian, as further described in Application 21247-A001.
2. The power plant shall consist of a natural gas-fired generator, with a total generating capability of 3.3-megawatts and as further described in Application 21247-A001.
3. EGPI shall submit a construction progress report to the Commission in writing, once every six months, pursuant to Section 3 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Regulation*. The first progress report shall be filed with the Commission six months from the date of issuance of this approval.
4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, construction of the power plant shall be completed by June 30, 2018.

5. EGPI shall notify the Commission within 30 days of completing the power plant.
6. EGPI shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any substantive changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in the application or what the Commission has approved.
7. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

Approval 21247-D02-2016 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
