**Transmission Line 501L Relocation
Proceeding 23067
Application 23067-A001**

Time extension

1. AltaLink Management Ltd. (AltaLink), by Application 23067-A001 registered with the Alberta Utilities Commission on October 27, 2017, requested approval of a time extension in order to complete the relocation and decommission of portions of transmission line 501L in the Coalspur area.
2. The proposed work is related to facilities previously approved by the Commission in Permit and Licence 22155-D02-2017¹ and Approval 22155-D03-2017,² where December 31, 2017, was stipulated as the completion date for the project.
3. AltaLink stated that it has reprioritized the project to 2018 and will be unable to complete the work by December 31, 2017.
4. AltaLink has provided information respecting the need, nature and the duration of the requested time extension. Based upon the information provided, AltaLink has demonstrated that the requested time extension is of a minor nature.
5. The Commission approves a time extension to December 31, 2018, for AltaLink to complete the relocation and decommission work for transmission line 501L.
