

# Transmission Line Permit and Licence 23067-D02-2017

AltaLink Management Ltd. Alter Transmission Line 501L	Proceeding 23067 Application 23067-A001

AltaLink Management Ltd. (AltaLink), pursuant to Permit and Licence 22155-D02-2017,<sup>1</sup> has approval to decommission and relocate portions of the 69-kilovolt (kV) transmission line 501L from the Coalspur 426S Substation to the Cardinal River 302S Substation in the Coalspur area.

AltaLink, by Application 23067-A001 registered on October 27, 2017, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval of a time extension beyond the previously approved date of December 31, 2017, in order to complete alteration of the transmission line.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 14, 15 and 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 23067-D01-2017<sup>2</sup> and granted to AltaLink a permit to alter and a licence to operate the transmission line, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The route of the transmission line shall be as shown on Appendix A and as described in Application 22155-A001 and previous applications.
2. Specifications of the transmission line shall include the following:
  - a) The transmission line shall be designed, built for and operated at a nominal voltage of 69 kV.
  - b) The structures shall be constructed of materials as specified in Application 22155-A001 and other previous approvals pertaining to the transmission line.
  - c) Other aspects of the alteration as more particularly described in Application 22155-A001 and other previous approvals pertaining to the transmission line.
3. AltaLink shall file with the Commission within 30 days of completing the transmission line alteration, the energization certificate(s) for the transmission line issued by AltaLink to confirm that the transmission line alteration has been completed and the transmission line is being operated in accordance with the provisions of this permit and licence.

4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, the transmission line alteration shall be completed by December 31, 2018.

Permit and Licence 22155-D02-2017 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this permit and licence, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this permit and licence, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
