Application for ATCO Electric Ltd. 2018 interim transmission facility owner tariff

Proceeding 23093 ATCO Electric Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for ATCO Electric Ltd.'s 2018 interim tariff to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the Commission to review before it makes its decision.

ATCO Electric Ltd. has filed an application requesting approval of its 2018 transmission tariff on an interim and refundable basis to take effect January 1, 2018. The rate to be charged to the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) would be \$49.9 million per month for transmission service provided to the AESO in the month of January 2018, and in each following month thereafter, until final transmission tariffs are established for ATCO Electric in a final decision of the Commission in respect of ATCO Electric's 2018-2019 general tariff application, or until further order or decision of the Commission. This monthly amount is based on an interim tariff of \$598.7 million for 2018, which represents a tariff decrease of \$75.1 million from the applied-for final 2017 tariff mainly due to ATCO Electric's proposal to refund previously collected construction work in progress in-rate base amounts.

Written submissions are due November 28, 2017.
