Application for legal determinations by the Alberta Utilities Commission pursuant to the jurisdiction granted to it by Section 8 of the Alberta Utilities Commission Act

Proceeding 23138 Alberta Electric System Operator

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering an application from the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) that requests legal determinations by the Commission, pursuant to jurisdiction granted to it by Section 8 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

The AESO seeks the Commission's determination of five legal questions that pertain to agreements for system access service under Rate STS, supply transmission service, of the Independent System Operator tariff, related to the Keephills Generating Units 1 and 2 Power Purchase Agreement.

Written submissions are due December 5, 2017.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 23138. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
