**Transfer of a 3.3-Megawatt Combined Heat and Power Cogeneration System
Proceeding 23243
Application 23243-A001**

Power plant ownership change

1. ENMAX Generation Portfolio Inc. (EGPI), by Application 23243-A001 registered on January 3, 2018, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 11 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* to transfer the ownership of the 3.3-megawatt combined heat and power cogeneration system, located at the ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre, to ENMAX Independent Energy Solutions Inc. (EIEI). The proposed ownership change is related to facilities previously approved by the Commission in Approval 22984-D02-2017.¹
2. EGPI submitted that EGPI and EIEI are both wholly owned subsidiaries of ENMAX Corporation. EIEI is a new wholly owned subsidiary of EGPI, and was established to hold EGPI's combined heat and power assets. EGPI requested the ownership transfer to take place in conjunction with EGPI's official transfer of the combined heat and power assets on January 15, 2018.
3. In accordance with the requirements of Section 23 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, EIEI is registered under the *Business Corporations Act*. Based upon the information provided, EIEI has demonstrated that it is eligible to hold the power plant approval in its name.
4. The Commission approves the power plant ownership change outlined in the application.
