ENMAX Independent Energy Solutions Inc. Ownership Transfer of a 3.3-Megawatt Cogeneration Power Plant	Proceeding 23243 Application 23243-A001

ENMAX Generation Portfolio Inc. (EGPI), pursuant to Approval 22984-D02-2017,¹ is the operator of the 3.3-megawatt heat and power cogeneration system at the ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre located at 435 Ninth Avenue S.E. Calgary, Alberta.

EGPI, by Application 23243-A001 registered on January 3, 2018, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval of an ownership change for the power plant from EGPI to ENMAX Independent Energy Solutions Inc. (EIEI).

The Commission, pursuant to sections 11 and 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 23243-D03-2018² and granted to EIEI an approval to own and operate the power plant, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in the southeast quarter of Section 15, Township 24, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian, as further described in Application 21247-A001.
2. The power plant shall consist of a natural gas-fired generator, with a total generating capability of 3.3 megawatts, and continue to be in accordance with Application 21247-A001.
3. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, construction of the power plant shall be completed by June 30, 2018.
4. EIEI shall notify the Commission within 30 days of completing the power plant.
5. EIEI shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any substantive changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in Application 21247-A001 or from what the Commission has approved.
6. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

7. This approval comes into effect on the official date of the combined heat and power assets transfer from EGPI to EIEI, planned to be on January 15, 2018.

Approval 22984-D02-2017 is rescinded, unless the assets transfer is not completed, in which case this approval is null and void.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
