ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 1724 for the following:

- splitting line 9 into lines 9, 28 and 29
- removal of line 28
- addition of newly constructed pipeline (line 30 – 0.05 kilometres of 508-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)
- addition of newly constructed pipeline (line 31 – 0.05 kilometres of 508-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)

The Commission amended Licence 1724 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 24728-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
