ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 1826 for the following:

- splitting line 25 into lines 25 and 75
- length amendment of original line 25 from 6.57 kilometres to the revised length of 6.38 kilometres

The Commission amended Licence 1826 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 24685-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
