ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 19223 for the following:

- splitting line 6 into lines 6, 8 and 9
- removal of line 8
- new construction - the addition of line 10, 0.20 kilometres of 60.3-millimetre outside diameter pipeline
- length amendment of original line 6 from 23.44 kilometres to 23.20 kilometres

The Commission amended Licence 19223 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 24642-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
