AltaGas Utilities Inc. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 22721 for the following:

- flow direction amendment of original line 44
- flow direction amendment of original line 45
- splitting line 45 into lines 45 and 57
- length amendment of original line 44 from 0.99 kilometres to the revised length of 0.93 kilometres
- length amendment of original line 45 from 5.28 kilometres to the revised length of 5.27 kilometres

The Commission amended Licence 22721 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 24660-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, the *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
