Irma Wind Power Project

Irma Wind GP Inc. has filed applications for a wind power project in the Wainwright/Irma area

Proceeding 22722
Applications 22722-A001 to 22722-A003

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the power plant development applications in Proceeding 22722. If you feel you may be affected by these applications you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

Written submissions are due May 17, 2019.

Irma Wind Limited Partnership, by its general partner, Irma Wind GP Inc., has applied to build and operate a 92.4-megawatt (MW) wind power project located in the Municipal District of Wainwright. The Commission issued a notice of applications for the project on July 4, 2017; however, amendments to the applications were received by the Commission on March 29, 2019. The applicant has selected its turbine technology and turbine layout for the project. The applications have been filed under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*.

The project would consist of 22 turbines out of a possible 24 turbines (i.e. two alternate turbine locations have been proposed) and each would use a 4.2-MW turbine with a hub height of 129 metres and a rotor diameter of 141 metres. The potential turbine locations are shown in the attached map. The project would also consist of a collector substation and a 34.5-kilovolt primarily underground collector system. The project area covers the following sections:
