Further ruling on standing

1. The Alberta Utilities Commission issued a notice of applications for Proceeding 24102 on January 31, 2019, setting a deadline for written submissions of March 8, 2019. On March 19, 2019, and again on May 10, 2019, the Commission issued a standing ruling granting various parties standing to participate in the above-noted proceeding.¹
2. On June 12, 2019, Kyle Kaziechko submitted a statement of intent to participate indicating that he owns land within 200 metres of the proposed project. Mr. Kaziechko stated that he is opposed to the project being constructed on the north side of TWP510 and expressed concerns with negative health impacts and safety issues.
3. The Commission has authorized me to communicate its decision on standing.

Ruling

4. The Commission has determined that Mr. Kaziechko owns land within close proximity of the proposed project and has demonstrated that he has legal rights that may be directly and adversely affected by the Commission's decision on the applications. The potential effects described by Mr. Kaziechko include negative health effects and safety issues. Accordingly, Mr. Kaziechko is granted standing to participate fully at the oral hearing, including giving evidence, questioning of witnesses and providing argument.
5. As Mr. Kaziechko's submission, was received one day prior to the deadline for intervenor evidence, the Commission is prepared to grant Mr. Kaziechko an extension to file evidence until June 21, 2019, should he wish to supplement the information he provided in his statement of intent to participate.
