Ruling on standing

1. The Commission issued a notice of application for Proceeding 24363 on April 11, 2019, and, in response, received one statement of intent to participate by the scheduled deadline. On May 27, 2019, the Commission issued a ruling granting Phillip and Natalie Dompnier standing in this proceeding and subsequently scheduled an oral hearing to commence on August 27, 2019. The hearing will consider Kneehill Solar LP's application to construct and operate a 25-megawatt solar power plant in the Drumheller area.
2. On June 21, 2019, Duane Olson provided a late-filed statement of intent to participate in the proceeding. In this ruling, the Commission decides whether Mr. Olson is granted standing to participate in the oral hearing.
3. The Commission has authorized me to communicate its decision on standing.

Ruling

4. Mr. Olson requests to intervene in support of the application as he is a participating landowner in the project. Mr. Olson owns land on which the proposed project is located, and as a result the Commission is satisfied that its decision on the application has the potential to result in a direct and adverse effect on him. For this reason, Mr. Olson is granted standing to participate in this proceeding.
