WCSB GP I Ltd. Transfer of Judy Creek GEN1 Power Plant Approval	Proceeding 24519 Application 24519-A001

Genalta GP I Ltd., pursuant to Approval U2014-290,¹ is the operator of the GEN1 Power Plant within the Pengrowth Judy Creek salt water plant, located in the Whitecourt/Swan Hills, Alberta area.

WCSB Power Generation GP Inc., by Application 24519-A001 registered on April 17, 2019, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission to transfer the power plant approval from Genalta GP I Ltd. to WCSB GP I Ltd. to reflect a change of ownership of the power plant, henceforth referred to as Judy Creek GEN1.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 11, 19 and 23 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 24519-D01-2019² and granted to WCSB GP I Ltd. an approval to operate the power plant, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in Legal Subdivision 7, Section 6, Township 64, Range 10, west of the Fifth Meridian.
2. The power plant shall consist of a thermal induction power plant using an Organic Rankin Cycle process, with a total generating capability of 2.1 megawatts, and as further described in Application 1607631.
3. WCSB GP I Ltd. shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any material changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design and/or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in Application 1607631 or from what the Commission has approved.

4. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

Approval U2014-290 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

The Commission may, within 30 days of the date of this approval and without notice, correct typographical, spelling and calculation errors and other similar types of errors and post the corrected approval on its website.
