Brooks Solar II Power Plant

Elemental Energy Renewables Inc. has filed an application to construct and operate a 26.5-megawatt solar power plant in the Brooks area

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the power plant development and interconnection application in Proceeding 24573. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

Written submissions are due July 26, 2019.

Elemental Energy Renewables Inc. has applied to construct and operate the Brooks Solar II Power Plant. The project is proposed to be located in the northwest and southeast quarters of Section 3, Township 19, Range 14, west of the Fourth Meridian, adjacent to the existing Brooks Solar I Power Plant.

The Brooks Solar II Power Plant would be located on approximately 88 hectares of privately owned agricultural land. The project would consist of a 26.5-megawatt solar power plant, including solar panels, inverter stations and a collector system. The project is proposed to connect to the FortisAlberta Inc. 25-kilovolt distribution system. The application has been filed under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*.
