Western Sustainable Power Inc. Summerview 354S Substation	Proceeding 24622 Application 24622-A001

Western Sustainable Power Inc.,¹ pursuant to Permit and Licence U2013-412,² is the operator of Summerview 354S Substation. By Application 24622-A001, registered on June 4, 2019, TransAlta Corporation, on behalf of Western Sustainable Power Inc., applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval to correct the name of the substation.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 14, 15 and 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 24622-D01-2019³ and granted Western Sustainable Power Inc. a licence to operate the substation, which had inadvertently been referred to as Summerview 854S in previous permits and licences, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The substation shall be wholly located in the southwest quarter of Section 30, Township 7, Range 28, west of the Fourth Meridian.
2. Specifications of the substation shall be:
 - a) two 138/34.5-kilovolt (kV) transformers
 - b) one 138-kV circuit breaker
 - c) three 34.5-kV circuit breakers
 - d) one 8.0-megavolt-ampere reactive (MVAR) direct (DVAR) voltage control device
 - e) six 6.6-MVAR capacitor banks
 - f) associated substation equipment
 - g) an enclosure surrounded by a chain-link fence and other substation equipment as described in all previous applications

The Commission may, within 30 days of the date of this permit and licence and without notice, correct typographical, spelling and calculation errors and other similar types of errors and post the corrected permit and licence on its website.
