

# Notice of applications

## Jenner Wind Power Project amendment

Jenner 1 Inc. has filed applications for an amendment to the previously approved Jenner Wind Project in the Jenner area

**Proceeding 24718**  
**Applications 24718-A001 to 24718-A004**

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the wind power project amendment applications in Proceeding 24718. If you feel you may be affected by these applications you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

**Written submissions are due August 19, 2019.**

Jenner 1 Inc. has applied, under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, to amend the approved, but not yet constructed, Jenner Wind Power Project. The project consists of the 122.4-megawatt (MW) Jenner Wind Power Plant, the Halsbury 306S Substation and 240-kilovolt Transmission Line 949L. The proposed amendment includes:

- changing the turbine model to Goldwind 4.2-MW turbines
- reducing the number of turbines from 36 to 29
- adjusting the location of turbines within 50 metres of the approved turbine locations
- changing equipment in the Halsbury 306S Substation resulting in a larger footprint
- minor alterations to the routing of Transmission Line 949L

The capability of the individual wind turbines would increase from 3.4-MW to 4.2 MW, but the total capability of the power plant would remain unchanged at 122.4-MW. The new turbines would have a total height of 187.5 metres, an increase of nine metres compared to the previously approved turbines.

The power plant and substation locations are shown on the attached map. The transmission line alterations can be found in Exhibit 24718-X0022 in Proceeding 24718 on the AUC's eFiling System.

**Please note that a separate project, the Jenner Wind Power Expansion Project, was applied for on August 8, 2017, and is currently on hold in Proceeding 22866. If you have previously provided a written submission in Proceeding 22866 but wish to participate regarding the amendment to the Jenner Wind Power Project, a new submission must be provided in Proceeding 24718 by August 19, 2019.**
