## 2018 annual transmission access charge deferral account (TACDA) true-up application

**Proceeding 24729**  
**FortisAlberta Inc.**

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering FortisAlberta Inc.'s 2018 annual transmission access charge deferral account (TACDA) true-up application to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

Fortis has filed an application requesting approval of its 2018 annual TACDA true-up, a net refund of approximately \$27 million, by way of a rider effective January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020.

**Written submissions are due September 3, 2019.**
