## Application for 2019 distribution tariff phase II filing

**Proceeding 24747**  
**ATCO Electric Ltd.**

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for ATCO Electric's 2019 distribution tariff phase II filing to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

In the application, ATCO Electric is requesting approval for:

- (a) the Maintenance Multiplier process becoming a notification only process;
- (b) its proposed Distribution and Transmission Tariffs; and
- (c) its proposed Terms and Conditions of Service.

ATCO Electric has undertaken a full Cost of Service Study (COSS) and corresponding Tariff Design in order to review existing rate classes for accuracy in Revenue/Cost (R/C) ratios.

The table below illustrates the rate class impact that would arise by implementing the proposed rate changes.
