Application for compliance filing to Decision 22393-D02-2019 for the 2012-2015 transmission deferral account for Hanna Regional Transmission Development program

Proceeding 24753 ATCO Electric Ltd. (Transmission)

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for ATCO Electric Ltd.'s compliance filing with respect to Decision 22393-D02-2019¹ to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

ATCO Electric Ltd. has filed an application requesting approval for its compliance filing with respect to Decision 22393-D02-2019, ATCO Electric Ltd.'s 2012-2015 transmission deferral account for Hanna Regional Transmission Development (HRTD) program. Based on its responses to nine Commission directions, ATCO Electric Ltd. provided an updated deferral account and annual filing for adjustment balances and is requesting that the AUC approve certain amounts using a settlement date for the collection of balances from the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) of March 2, 2020.

The updated collection balances were presented by ATCO Electric Ltd. under two separate calculations. Should the Commission direct ATCO Electric Ltd. to remove certain salvage costs, the total revised collection from the AESO will be an amount of \$8.8 million. Should the Commission approve the collection of salvage costs, the total revised collection from the AESO will be an amount of \$3.7 million.

Written submissions are due August 7, 2019.
