Stirling Wind Project Ltd. Connect Red Coat 967S Substation to AltaLink Management Ltd.'s Transmission Line 820BL	Proceeding 24756 Application 24756-A003

Stirling Wind Project LP, by its general partner Stirling Wind Project Ltd., pursuant to Connection Order 22546-D04-2019,¹ has approval to connect Red Coat 967S Substation to AltaLink Management Ltd.'s Transmission Line 820BL. By Application 24756-A003, registered on July 23, 2019, Stirling Wind Project Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval to transfer ownership of Connection Order 22546-D04-2019 to Stirling Renewable Energy Limited Partnership, to be held by its general partner, Stirling Wind Project Ltd.

The Commission approved the application in Decision 24756-D01-2019,² and granted to Stirling Renewable Energy Limited Partnership, to be held by its general partner, Stirling Wind Project Ltd. (Stirling) an order to connect Red Coat 967S Substation to AltaLink's Transmission Line 820BL, pursuant to Section 18 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*. This approval is subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. Stirling may connect Red Coat 967S Substation to AltaLink's Transmission Line 820BL in the northwest quarter of Section 8, Township 7, Range 18, west of the Fourth Meridian, as indicated in Application 22546-A003.
2. The specifications of the connection shall be as set out as in Application 22546-A003.
3. The connection shall be operated so that except under short-term emergency conditions:
 - (a) The flows of real and reactive power are those for which the connection is designed and which it is intended to carry on a continuous basis.
 - (b) No excessive surges of 60-hertz power or excessive exchange of power frequency harmonics shall occur between the systems connected.

4. This order is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

Order 22546-D04-2019 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this order, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this order, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

The Commission may, within 30 days of the date of this order and without notice, correct typographical, spelling and calculation errors and other similar types of errors and post the corrected order on its website.
