## Compliance filing to Decision 23102-D01-2019

### Proceeding 24761 ENMAX Power Corporation

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering ENMAX Power Corporation's compliance filing application to Decision 23102-D01-2019<sup>1</sup> to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

The application addresses the directions issued in Decision 23102-D01-2019. In the application, ENMAX is seeking approval to refund to customers \$2.19 million of the 2015 and 2016 K factor amounts along with \$0.24 million of the associated carrying costs for the PG4-A-4 Proactive Cable Replacement and PG4-A-8 Overhead Conductor Replacement projects via a distribution access service (DAS) rider over the January 1, 2020 to March 31, 2020 period. The DAS rider will be included in ENMAX's 2020 performance-based regulation (PBR) annual filing application. ENMAX is also seeking approval for 2017 K factor amounts for the PG4-A-4 Proactive Cable Replacement and PG4-A-8 Overhead Conductor Replacement projects. ENMAX proposes to collect or refund the amounts associated with the 2017 K factor, including carrying costs, in its 2021 PBR annual filing application.

### Written submissions are due August 14, 2019.
