Application for 2019-2020 unaccounted-for gas Rate Rider E and Rate Rider H

Proceeding 24763 AltaGas Utilities Inc.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for AltaGas Utilities Inc.'s 2019-2020 unaccounted-for gas (UFG) Rate Rider E and Rate Rider H to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

AltaGas filed an application on July 24, 2019, requesting approval for the annual adjustment to UFG rate riders E and H. AltaGas is proposing to increase Rate Rider E from 1.04 per cent to 1.10 per cent, and Rate Rider H from 1.05 per cent to 1.11 per cent. The revised rates are to be effective November 1, 2019.

Written submissions are due August 8, 2019.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 24763. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
