2018 Annual transmission access charge deferral account true-up application (Rider G)

Proceeding 24779 ATCO Electric Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for ATCO Electric Ltd.'s 2018 annual transmission access charge (TAC) deferral account true-up (Rider G) to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

ATCO Electric has filed an application requesting approval for its 2018 annual TAC deferral account true-up. The 2018 TAC deferral account amount is a net refund of \$4.483 million to be dispersed to customers through Rider G. ATCO Electric proposed that this rider will be in effect for the 12-month period of January 1, 2020, to December 31, 2020.

Written submissions are due August 12, 2019.
