## Application for the sale of Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership to Genesee Lake Holding Corp. and certain indigenous communities

Proceeding 24792 Canadian Utilities Limited

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for the sale of Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership to Genesee Lake Holding Corp. and certain indigenous communities to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

On July 30, 2019, Canadian Utilities Limited filed an application requesting approval to sell Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership, owner and operator of the Fort McMurray West 500 kilovolt Transmission Project, to Genesee Lake Holding Corp. and certain indigenous communities. Canadian Utilities Limited and QSI Finance Canada ULC own an 80 per cent and a 20 per cent indirect equity interest in Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership, respectively. Upon approval, Genesee Lake Holding Corp. will hold interest in Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership between 60 per cent and 100 per cent, and certain indigenous communities that choose to purchase interest in Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership will hold interest between zero and 40 per cent.

## Written submissions are due August 14, 2019.
