Application to approve Genesee Lake Holding Corp. as a designated owner of a public utility

Proceeding 24793 Genesee Lake Holding Corp.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application by Genesee Lake Holding Corp., requesting to be added to the *Public Utilities Designation Regulation* as a designated owner of a public utility following the Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership sale transaction, to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

On July 30, 2019, Genesee Lake Holding Corp. filed an application related to a Share Purchase Agreement involving it, Canadian Utilities Limited, QSI Finance Canada ULC and other entities,¹ and requested approval to be added to the *Public Utilities Designation Regulation* as a designated owner of a public utility following its acquisition of up to 100 per cent ownership interest in Alberta PowerLine Limited Partnership, and to conduct itself as if it were a designated owner of a public utility following the closing of the acquisition but in advance of its inclusion in the *Public Utilities Designation Regulation*.

Written submissions are due August 14, 2019.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 24793. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
