Application for 2019 light-emitting diode lighting conversion maintenance multiplier

Proceeding 24795 ATCO Electric Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for ATCO Electric Ltd.'s 2019 light-emitting diode (LED) lighting conversion maintenance multiplier to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

ATCO Electric is requesting the use of the street light service rate maintenance multiplier of 1.067 for six municipalities in 2019. ATCO Electric has filed the signed acknowledgment letters from each of the municipalities, which contain information regarding the higher cost of the service, the maintenance multiplier to be effective in Price Schedule D61B for its invested street light service, and the conditions under which the calculation and assessed charges to the customer requesting the higher service levels can change.

Written submissions are due August 15, 2019.
